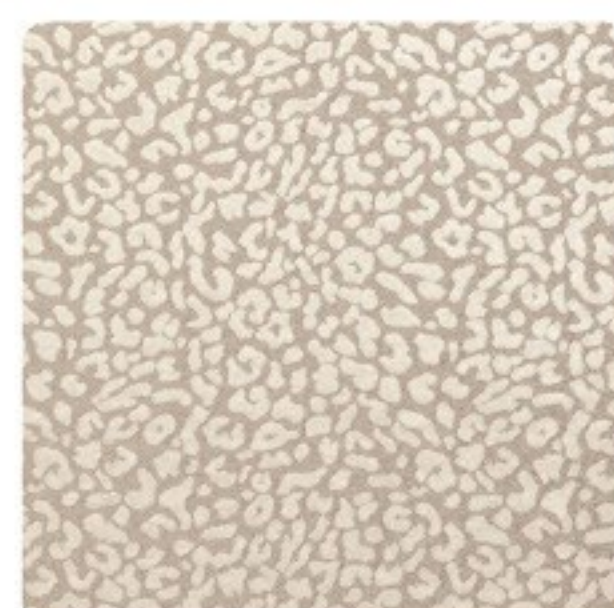


A DYNAMIC DESIGN ELEMENT PROVES THE KEY TO SOPHISTICATION

The existing hand-painted yellow wallpaper in the dining room of the American Red Cross Showhouse in Palm Beach wowed designer Katherine Shenaman. But she wanted furniture that would play against its vivid qualities and the moody nature of the room's Italianate architecture.
